Securing Cable to Locking Keystone Security Jack



Step 1: Fully insert RJ45 side of the Security Key into the keystone jack, and gently pull out the security bar about 1/4"



Step 2: The Locking Security Bar will slide out about 1/4" as shown.



Step 3: Hook the tab of the Patch Cord into the Locking Security Bar from below, and then insert the cable modular plug into the RJ45 until it snaps in place.



Step 4:
Once the cable is attached, it can still be removed until you push in on the locking bar and it snaps into place. Once the locking bar is snapped in, the patch cable cannot be removed without the

Removing Patch Cable from Locking Security Jack



Step 1:

Insert the side of the Security Key without the RJ45 adapter into the tab notch above the tab. Simultaneously hold down on the Security Key and patch cord plug, then gently pull out the cable and security bar about a 1/4".



Step 2: Gently unhook the tab of the patch cord from the locking security bar from below.

Step 3: Push in the Locking Security Bar with your finger until it snaps in place as shown. Once snapped in, a patch cord cannot be inserted without use of the Security Key.
